Attendance:


Number of members attended the meeting in person was 53 Number of members attended through Zoom was 5 Total Number of members attended the meeting was 58, as per the attached list

The following subjects were discussed as per the meeting Agenda:

- 1- Speech by HH shaikh Salman Bin Mohamed Bin Isa Alkhalifa, Vice President of Bahrain Sport Authority, where he has welcomed the members to the Kingdom of Bahrain and wished them all the success in works of the meetings.
- 2- Speech by HH Shaikh Isa Bin Ali Bin Khalifa Alkhalifa, Vice President for Bahrain Olympic Committee, where HH assured the support of Bahrain Olympic Committee for the activities of International Sports for All Federation, and also welcomed all the members to the kingdom of Bahrain, wishing them a pleasant stay in Bahrain and all success in the meetings.
- 3- Speech of HE Isa AbdulRahim, President of International Sport for All Federation, where he has opened the General Assembly with welcoming the members to the meeting and thanking them for making the presence to the Kingdom of Bahrain to participate in the General Assembly, and the Election of the Board of Directors for the term 2022 2026 with a great thankful to the International Olympic Committee (IOC).
- 4- **Approval of minutes** of previous General Assembly conducted in Italy, with no comments from members, and were unanimously approved.

- 5- **Comments from members:** Number of members have commented, and mainly thanked the host in the Kingdom of Bahrain for conducting the General Assembly and the Election of the Board of Directors, appreciating all the efforts put in making this event taking place with such number of attending members.
- 6- Other Subjects: HE Isa Abdulrahim, the President of FISpT, suggested to the General Assembly to develop a new branding exercise for the Federation to support the future plans for the Federation strategy, with new look in terms of colors, logo, and general appearance of the Federations activities. Members approved the suggestion and authorized the new Board to implement the proposal.
- 7- Election of the Board members for the term 2022 2026:

The floor was opened for volunteers to set the committee for the election process and the following four volunteers came forward:

- 4- Ms Sibilla Stefanomi

Prof. Dr. Omar Hindawi gave a brief explanation about the process of the election, mentioning that the number of candidates who have applied for the Board seats are 21 members and the number of seats which should be elected for the Board would be 16.

The ballot paper with the list of 21 candidates will be distributed to the members by calling each member by name, who should select from the list no more than 16 candidates, and then drop the ballot paper in the assigned box.
